To avoid this happening to your paper please ensure all the points below have been fulfilled.

### In order to ensure confirmed paper acceptance you must:

- 1) Make the **corrections** or **additions** suggested by the reviewers. Reviews can be found on the EDAS website.
- 2) Make sure that your paper is **correctly formatted**: Papers must be a maximum of 4 pages long, in 2 column format with **no** headers, footers or page numbers.

- 3) Your paper is **IEEE compliant**. All authors are required to use PDF eXpress.

- 4) Your final version must be uploaded to EDAS **before 25<sup>th</sup> August**.
- 5) Your paper has no major typographical errors and is in clear English. If English is not your first language please ensure that your paper is carefully checked by an English speaker. (Non-EU passport holders are reminded to apply early for visas as these can take some time.)
- 6) One author of your paper has completed a **copyright form**. Go to the EDAS site and follow the link from your paper to complete your IEEE copyright form This will appear once your paper has been accepted.
- 7) At least one author has **registered** for LAPC 2010. This is required for your paper to be included in the proceedings or on IEEE Xplore. You can register here:

- 8) ALL authors are **included** in the **author list in EDAS** and **each name and title must be written in exactly the same way** on EDAS and on the paper. If the name is incorrect or written differently in either place the authors' title will not appear correctly in the index of the proceedings and may not appear in IEEE searches so please check this carefully.
- 9) All papers are **POSTER** presentations. Note it is IEEE policy to only include papers in IEEE Xplore when the authors have attended the conference and presented their work. Your poster should be **A0** in size, in **colour** and in **portrait** orientation. Please bring your poster with you.
